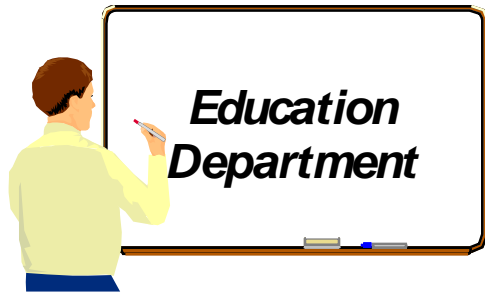
Hello everyone!

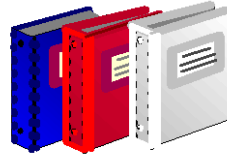
