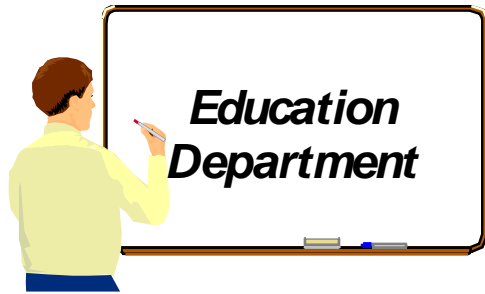

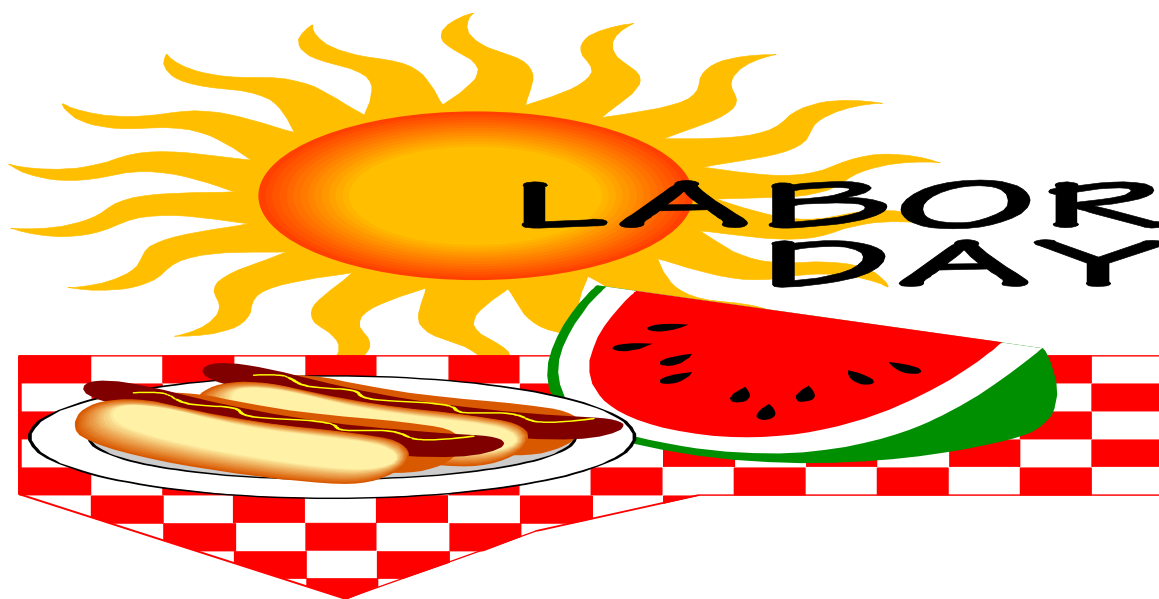

# MEMBER INVOLVEMENT

I dislike writing this article for the September *LOG* because it means we are getting closer to the end of the boating season. A real indication is that the first day of Autumn is September 23, just a few days after our Fall Rendezvous.

Before I write about the Rendezvous, let's start with what else is about to happen this month. During Labor Day weekend (Sept 2 to Sept 4), we will be holding our routine raft-ups. Saturday's raft-up is at Coast Guard Cove, Sunday is at Captree Cove and Monday's Holiday raft-up is at Massapequa Cove. I hope that we will have good weather for each of these days.

On Wednesday, September 6th, at the Moose Lodge, the women of Captree will be making baskets for Captree's infamous Baskets' Raffle to be conducted at the Fall Rendezvous. Over the years, they have made from forty to fifty baskets that are always the hit of the Rendezvous. Come and join the group at the Moose Lodge on the 6th. It will be an evening of fun and laughs.

Now it's time to write about the Rendezvous. It starts on Saturday, September 16th with set-up under the tent in the morning. (Tent will be erected on Friday by an outside contractor.) Then at 12:30PM, Captree will officially kick off the Rendezvous with its Potluck Lunch. If you plan to attend, bring your favorite dish to share. Every year when I write about this I always say that this to me is the best meal of the day because of the variety and the amount of food people bring. After lunch, the Baskets' Raffle will be conducted which draws all the boaters and campers to our tent where they all try their luck to win a basket of goodies. Then comes our evening BBQ buffet dinner catered by Dang BBQ in Seaford.

The best part of the Rendezvous is Sunday morning when the smell of bacon being cooked on our grill by Chief Chef Gene Johnson brings all our Captree members and guests under the tent to enjoy Bacon and Eggs on a roll along with Mimosas or Bloody Mary's. What could be better than that?

There is a flyer with a reservation form in this *LOG* to complete and send to Rossie Teresco. Please do so by September 10th and join in on all to the fun! Non-residents going by boat must contact Mike Richter who is coordinating slip assignments with the Town. Residents going by boat must reserve a slip through the Town's reservation system.

Now, what happened at the end of July and during the month of August? In my last article I wrote that several boats were heading East to the Townsend Manor Inn & Marina in Greenport and then on to Newport, Rhode Island as the two beginning legs of Captree's Summer Cruise. Unfortunately, two boats were unable to continue to Newport. First, Frank and Kathy Verderber had problems with an outdrive just north of the Shinnecock Canal and limped into Greenport on one engine. Having diagnosed the problem as an outdrive issue with the help of numerous mechanics via phone, they elected to have their boat hauled on land back to their mechanic in Seaford. Second, Dave and Cindy Pafundi started out to Newport but also had problems with one engine and aborted the trip and headed back home to Massapequa.

The five remaining boats (Richter's, Peysson's, Teresco's, Biggs, & Robinson's) all made the trip to the Newport Harbor Hotel & Marina through calm water (2.8 swells) and sunny skies. Their four

After Newport the boaters headed back to Greenport for a one-night stay at Mitchell's Marina in the heart of the town. 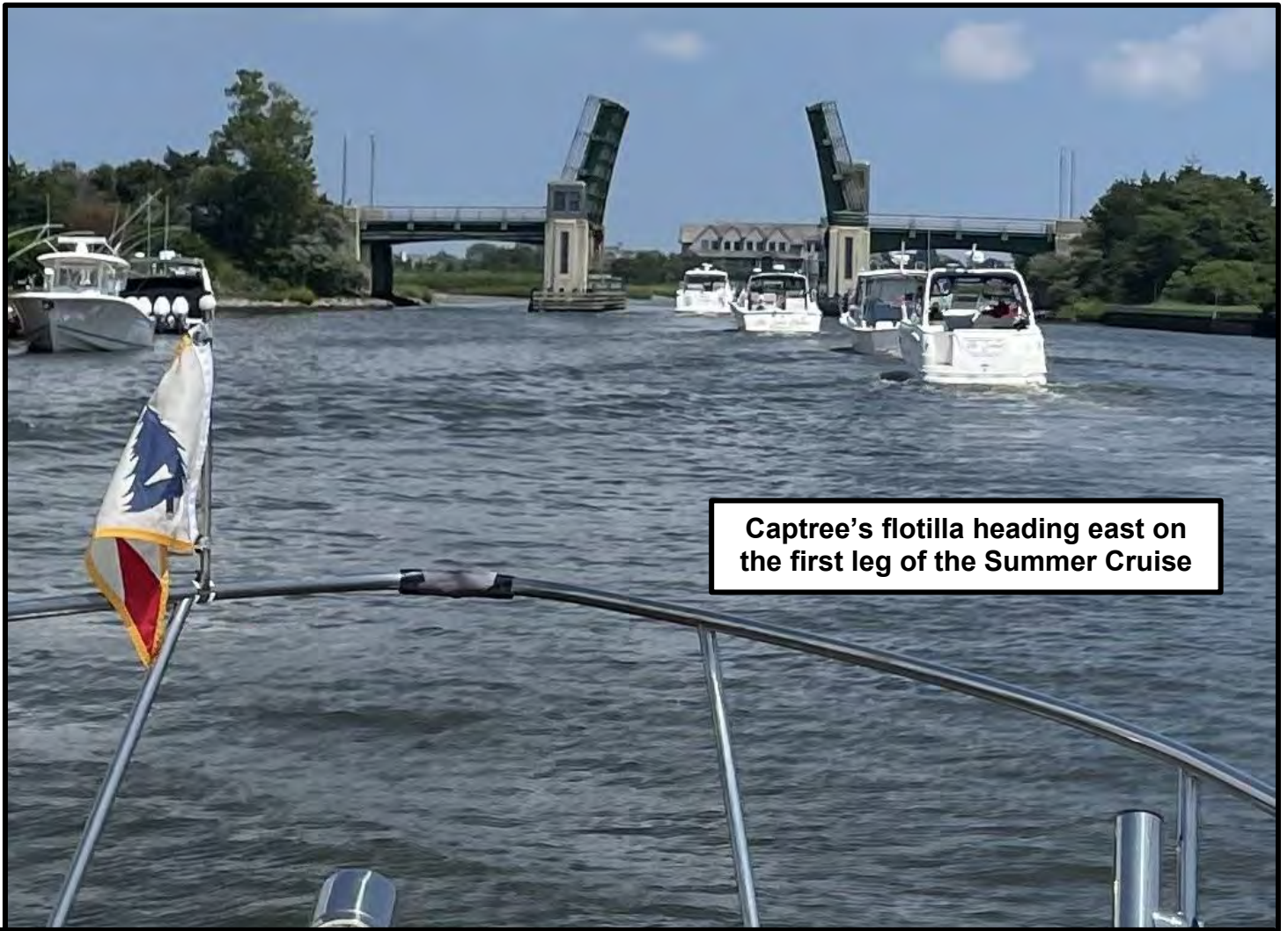
back to their boats early because of the severe thunderstorms and rain.

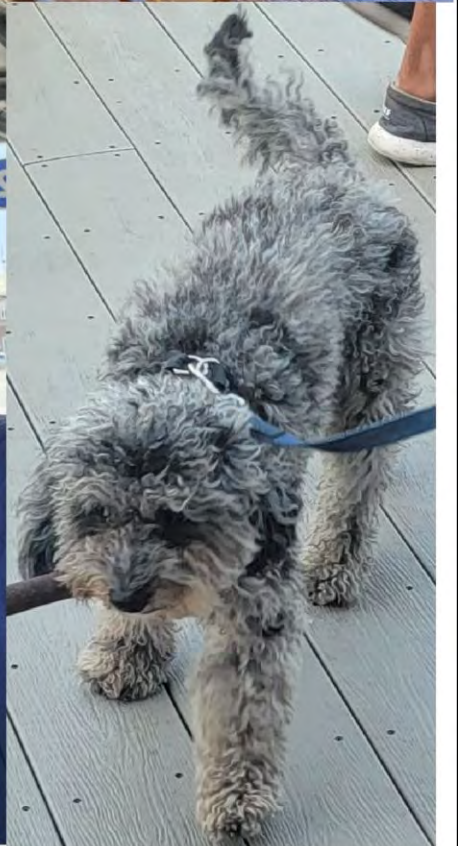
